

HIGH RISK WORK LICENCES AND THE REQUIREMENTS

High Risk Work Licenses	<i>Requirements</i>
CB – Bridge & Gantry Crane High Risk Work Licence	Crane has 4 or more powered movements, i.e: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Travelling – Movement along crane runway • Traversing – Movement along the bridge • Hoisting – Raising and Lowering • Rotating – Hook or attachment rotates via crane’s support movement. Exemptions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Crane lacks an operator cabin • Pendant control with 3 or less powered movements.
DG - Dogging High Risk Work License	Minimum requirement for Gantry Crane use when the operator is required to exercises judgment selecting slings, estimating the weight of the load or its centre of gravity. Where there is a need to direct a gantry crane operator in the movement of the load.
RB – Basic Rigging High Risk Work Licence	Requires an individual to achieve a Statement of Attainment in ‘CPCCLDG3001 Licence to perform dogging’. Perform dogging work and operate a Gantry Crane with three or fewer powered movements.
RIIHAN305D Operate a gantry or overhead crane and RIIHAN203E Conduct lifting operations	Nationally recognised units of competency available for Gantry Crane operators with three or fewer powered movements
